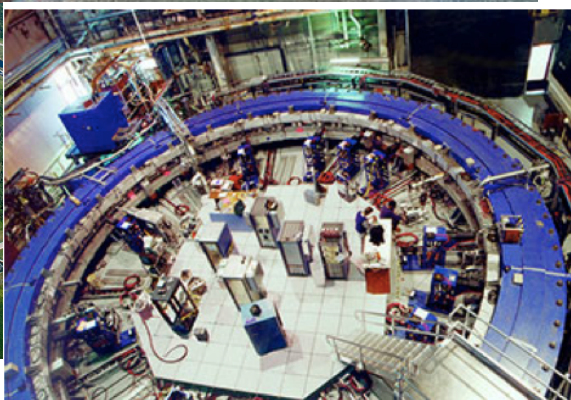
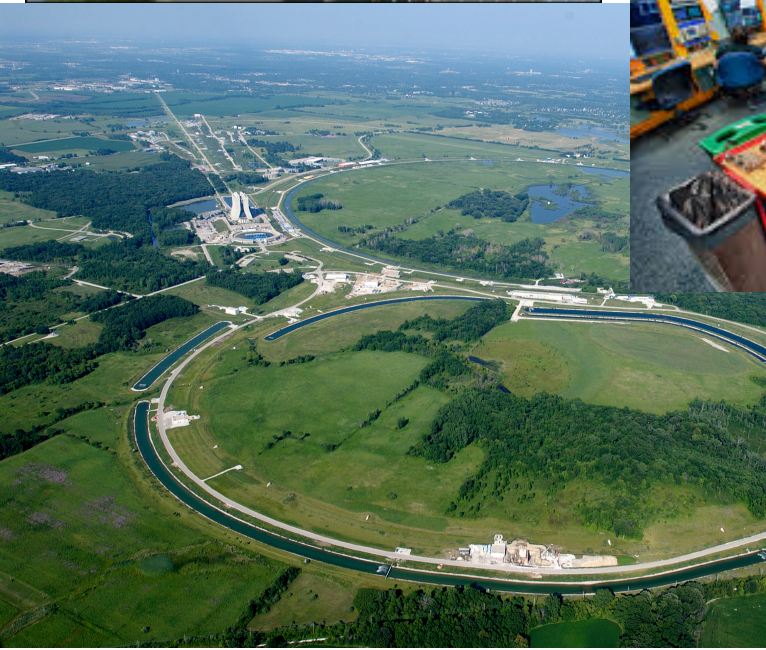
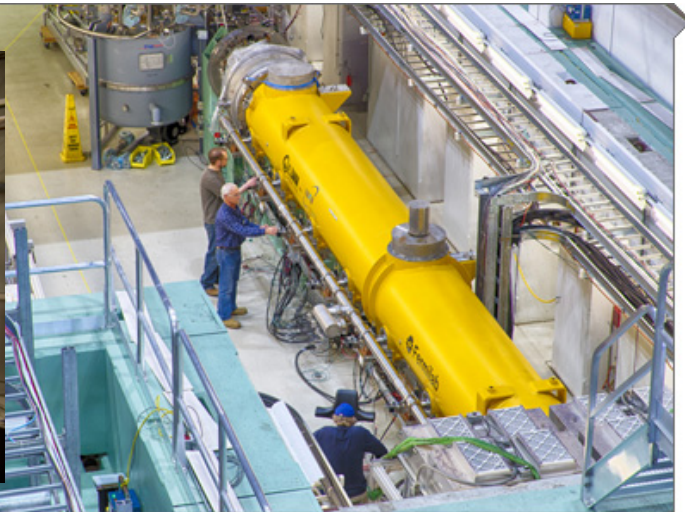
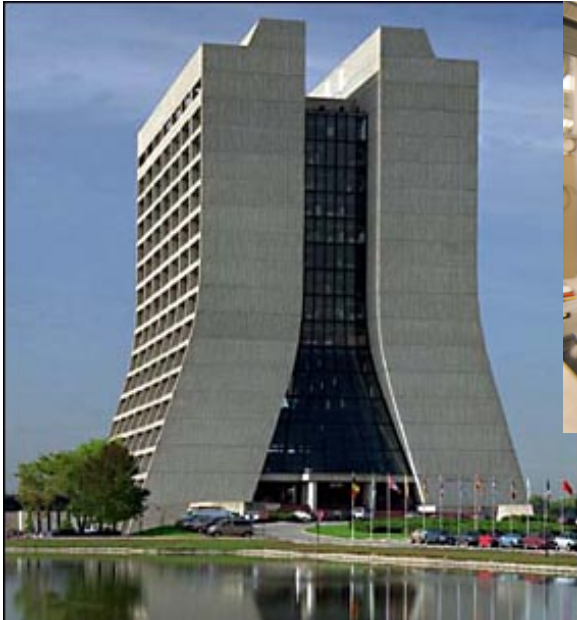
Some stats

- Total knowledge of physics acquired - **priceless**



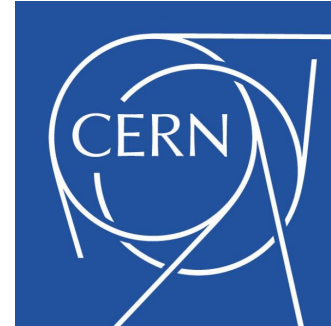
