A Diversity and Inclusion Task Force for the Mu2e Experiment was formed in January of 2017. The charge was to "determine how Mu2e can effectively promote and develop diversity and inclusion within the experiment" with the goal of presenting a set of recommendations to the experiment at the June, 2017 Collaboration Meeting.
