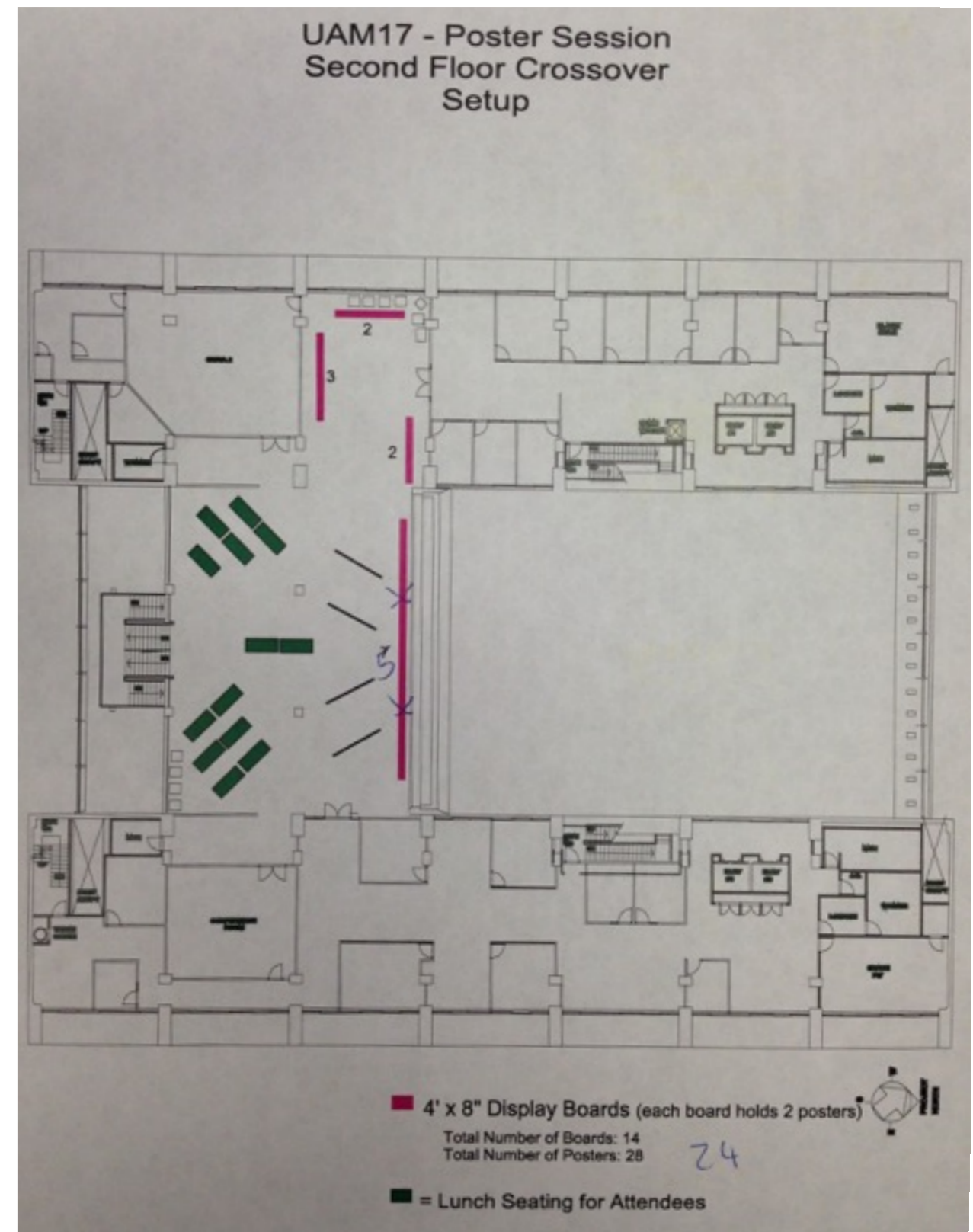

URA Visiting Scholars Award Update

- Received the URA Visiting Scholars User Meeting traveling grant
 - Awarded 10k dollars
 - reimbursement of up to \$1,000 in travel cost for each awardee
 - Awardees are expected to submit out-of-pocket travel expenses and are reimbursed directly by URA at the end of the trip.
 - Awardees' responsibilities are:
 - Arrange their travel (flights, hotel, etc)
 - Complete a travel reimbursement form
 - Attach copies of all receipts
 - Fill out a signed W9 document
 - Write a brief report on the project
- An announcement was sent to the FSPA list (April 3rd) and spokespersons and division heads (April 11th).
 - Received 5 applications
 - May support the URA thesis awardee if funds are available
 - Stop accepting applications on April 30th
- Expect another announcement in the upcoming remainder of the 50th year anniversary symposium and user meeting
