How should we organize Consortium meetings?

- IB rep meetings vs All meetings
 - Should we have them separate? But initially (until the RRB deadline in November) it makes sense to have just one meeting until the internal structure is defined.
 - For the "all" meetings, the priority is again IB reps+members in the consortium institutions (non-members can join if the chosen time works for them)
- Frequency of the meetings?
- My goal is to hold weekly focused meetings so we can converge on the milestones for the RRB deadline
 - Mid-October CRB review
 - November 2nd RRB review

- I have started refining the list of deliverables, will reach out to members with a template of requested items that will help me to further refine the list of deliverables. I have also gathered the WBS from ProtoDUNEs and other experiments as an example.
- A note on "Institutional" Responsibilities (will do this in October)
 - Note at this point, this is more like "aspirational" responsibilities, but with some realistic possibility of funding behind them)
 - Commitment, planning and funding will come late (around 2019) ⁶

Some items discussed at the TB meeting


- Imbalance in the Consortia
 - A lot of consortia still need more institutes, some have enough, some don't (e.g. our consortium!)
 - Need to reach out for more members (if you think anyone or any institute is a suitable candidate for our consortium, please let me know and I will reach out to them, you should feel free to do so as well)
 - Would be good to know what % of the collaboration is signed up for Consortia to know who to reach out to
- On the above point, what is the procedure to add new members? There is benefit in making this uniform b/n consortia.
- How do deal with deliverables that have overlap between consortia?
- For both of the above, the Technical Board meetings will server as a venue for discussion


WBS Structuring: Suggestions from Project Office

Consortium Organization

- Technical Lead needs to be appointed
- Internal structure for the Consortium needs to be defined
 - Working groups defined and conveners selected
- Some items to consider:
 - What is DUNE vs LBNF vs Other Consortium responsibility?
 - Our consortium is unique in the sense that we have a stronger connection with LBNF and also a lot of interfacing with other consortia
 - This is a joint consortium for a reason, so don't want to separate SP vs DP
 - Also need to take into development activities (technical and otherwise) that sit outside of the ProtoDUNE scope for 2018/2019 need to be identified and put into the project office schedule

Initial thoughts – Consortium Organization

- A WG interfacing with LBNF?
 - Will consist of members from consortium and LBNF
- Cryogenic Instrumentation WG?
- Slow Controls WG?
- These seem too broad, but,
 - Would like to minimize the no. of WGs
 - Keep SP and DP joint
 - Also, initially all systems need to talk to each other until it is clear what system does what
- With time, the focus of these groups will evolve (overall design, hardware vs software, infrastructure, integration, test facility, physics etc.)
