


## Changing Faces


- With the new year of the UEC we will be transitioning the leadership of the Government Relations Subcommittee

#### October D.C. Visit

- Currently organizing a trip to D.C. in October (week of 10/9)
- The focus of this trip is to send a small contingent (5 UEC representatives) to meet with the major congressional committees (majority and minority) and the IL and SD delegations
  - House Subcommittees
    - Approp: Commerce, Justice, Science
    - Approp: Energy & Water Development
    - Science, Space & Tech: Energy
    - Science, Space & Tech: R&T
  - Senate Subcommittees
    - Approp: Commerce, Justice, Science
    - Approp: Energy & Water Development
    - Commerce, Science, & Transportation: Space, Science and Competitiveness
    - Energy and Natural Resources: Energy
- This will be timed to correspond with the next fall budget negotiation
  - With a focus on thanking them for their continued support and reinforcing the importance that funding at the P5
    levels will allow us to continue our success in implementing the plans endorsed in H.R. 589
    - House "Department of Energy Research and Innovation Act"

### Status of October Trip

- Funding was approved by Directorate on September 6th
- A meeting of stake-holders happened on September 5th to discuss ongoing planning
  - Representatives of USLHC and Fermilab UEC attended
  - Plans were made to reach out to DPF and SLUO
- Need to finalize who is attending in the next couple weeks and begin laying out logistics

# Big Yearly Trip

- Thanks to all the work of last year we have great up-todate material to bring on this years trip
- Want to integrate the feedback we got last year into this years packet
  - More astro representation
  - More NSF representation (IceCube)
  - Grant and procurement information per district
  - Build upon the success of the rulers by including google-cardboard with instructions to view a LArTPC or collider event display
- Want to revamp the connections program to adjust weights of personal connections and pre-meetings with that district
- Focus on producing scripted example of meetings and scenarios that are common

# Bigger Yearly Meeting

- Recently the budget of the trip was increased such that we can attempt to have 100% coverage of congress for this year's trip
