- Noutrino Dhysics



Results of the Survey : Festa Italiana




Number of Users who answered the questions

Remaining Questions	<21>	


- Majority of the users preferred for the event to start earlier.

Did you attend the 50th Anniversary Symposium?






- 80% of the users are satisfied with the length of the coffee breaks and < 2% didn't like the food.

If the Directorate, most whom rarely interact with us scientists, haven't thanked the organizers yet, why not? It was clearly a lot of work and a labor of love.


Speakers, some speakers are not associated to Fermilab very much but forced to speak about historical events of Fermilab anyway.

I liked the first day as it was...especially as a non-physicist.


They ran out of copies of the program book and I didn't get one.




Which sessions did you attend at the Users Meeting on June 8?



What should be the goal of the Users Meeting? Please rank in order of importance:








This year's Users Meeting did not have a public lecture. Did you miss it?
