Releases

Last week

- V07_03_00 released on Aug 23
 - No e15 version available
 - Added TrajCluster Slice
 - FHICL-configurable recombination parameters

• This week

- Fixes for LArG4 re-factoring
- Waiting to hear from several others about changes



larsim to lardetsim migration

- Will migrate larsim to lardetsim to fix 10 GB problem in history
- Outline of draft procedure
 - Freeze the larsim repository
 - Developers should expect to push current state of all feature branches to central repository prior to the freeze
 - Create a release
 - Central larsim repository history will be cleaned, migrated to lardetsim
 - Create a new release that uses lardetsim instead of larsim
 - All larsim references on head of develop across LarSoft will be fixed at release
 - Content is otherwise identical to the first.
 - Go live

Expect this to take ~1 day

 All steps will be rehearsed in advance to ensure everything goes smoothly during the actual migration



larsim to lardetsim migration

- Several cases to address for developers / users
 - Case I: user pushed private code as recommended
 - The only method that will preserve histories...
 - Case II: user did not push private branch, but it exists on central repository
 - Case III: did not push private branch, but it does not exist in repository

Slight changes in migration procedure for each, none difficult

- In all cases, will have scripts to fix references to larsim
- The details will be documented in advance on the LArSoft wiki
- Schedule
 - Earliest is to do this the week of Sept 10
 - Will get sign-off from all experiments



The procedure to commit code to LArSoft

- LArSoft thrives because many people contribute detectorindependent code to the core LArSoft repositories
- Want the barriers to such contributions to be as low as possible
- Current procedure for merging code strains LArSoft project resources
 - Changes in CI support, available personnel has had adverse impact
- Drafting a new policy for committing code to LArSoft
 - Will require all code to be tested on CI system prior to being merged

No change yet

- Working on tools to help automate, make this as easy as possible
- May be integrated in other planned changes to repository hosting
- Now just making people aware of this coming change, seeking feedback
