## Recommendations

- Have larger projects outline their computing models and the methods used to estimate their requested resources.
- provide more time for discussions of the action plan with 1. experiments and 2. SCD
- Improve the review template by reexamining the technical metrics
- 2. Developing well defined policies for CPU performance and storage.
- There is a need to improve the efficiency of managing resources
- Enforce policies via automated quotas and allocations.
- Develop tools to incentivize users who follow the policies.
- Facilitate on-boarding of the experiments and reduce the long-term direct support.



## Recommendations (2)

- 4. The absence of high performance storage solutions has forced the experiments to use expensive systems in an inefficient way.
  - An example would be the NAS (both old and expensive)
  - Storage needs a sustainable philosophy
- 5. Continue efforts to develop and implement common tools across frontiers.
- 6.SCD should identify 5% of its budget that can be used for R&D activities toward future hardware/software advances.
  - No flexibility remains for identifying and updating current services and infrastructure.
  - This is not sustainable
