Some history and a proposal

- Presentation from Tara Turner on revised joint appointments policy
 - Developed to address concerns of the DOE FSO: handling of intellectual property rights, conflict of interests, reception and documentation of reimbursements to DOE

- WDRS revision focused on important business and legal aspects of the policy
- May be the SAC should take the opportunity to revisit the policy from the perspective of its scientific outcome

- Proposal of a survey to be filled out by (at least) the joint appointees
 - Employment, teaching, resources and funding, benefits to the physics program and institutions
