## Taxi service pilot announced June 03, 2019

Dear Fermilab Community,

Starting June 3rd, the Facilities Engineering Services Section (FESS) will initiate a pilot program that will balance the needs of all Laboratory personnel (employees and non-employees). The pilot will run from June 3rd to August 2nd. After August 2nd, another schedule will be announced that will incorporate taxi route changes to facilitate the closing of the east parking lot of Wilson Hall for the Integrated Engineering Research Center construction.

In coordination with the Global Services office, we have developed a morning and afternoon route that will impact the current taxi service operation. The new schedule will have multiple options for passengers needing to travel within our site. The initial schedule will be as indicated below, however, please note that we may alter it depending on location usage.
