Releases

- Last week
 - v08_13_01 released on 3/18
 - Fixes for bugs in larsim
 - v08_13_02 released on 3/21
 - Cleanups to code and CMakeLists.txt files
 - Changes to develop
- This week
 - No merge requests so far

Migration to root v6.16/00 + *art* v3.02

- Planned to migrate to root v6.16/00
 - to fix an `iorule` problem observed by MicroBooNE that breaks `anab::ParticleID`
- accompanied by move to *art* v3.02
 - Breaks backwards compatibility of `anab::ParticleID`
- Status
 - Did not happen last week as originally planned
 - Expect to complete the migration this week
 - Want to update MicroBooNE production branch also (!!)

Status Genie v3

- Still waiting for a tag
 - Genie is still working on fixing various bugs that have been found in validation
 - No estimate
- Once the new version is released, will need sign-off from every experiment
 - What are the plans of experiments?

caffe support

- LArSoft team proposes dropping support, distribution of caffe
 - Unaware of anyone using caffe at present
 - Presents a non-negligible overhead to include in the build
 - Currently have an e17 build, but not an e19 build
 - TensorFlow is now and will continue to be available
