



¹ The collaboration shall be entitled to request that the contract is awarded only on the condition that at least 50% of the value of the bid originates from the country(ies) providing the funding for the contract. In such case this condition shall be specified in the Invitation to Tender documents.

² The procurement process shall not be initiated without this document being provided.

³ In case the proof of correctness is not provided, tendering by CERN.

⁴ In case the transfer of risks and liability is not provided, FC approval tender is required.

⁵ Only consider CERN contribution to the total contractual amount. FC approval needed only if CERN participation >750kCHF or in case of single tender if CERN participation >200kCHF.

⁶ CERN Procurement Service has the right to require a transfer of risks and liability before processing the DAI, if it deems the particular circumstances of the project make it necessary (eg. contractual risk, complexity of the supply etc.)
