The lab used to have something called the Director's Outreach Award. This was an outreach award funded by Fermilab Friends for Science Education, a non-profit organization that facilitates interactions between Fermilab and neighboring communities. Last year, we moved the venue for the presentation to the Family Open House in February since this is also an event sponsored by Fermilab Friends.

We are looking for a better venue and the users meeting came up as a possibility. This would allow the recipient to gain more peer recognition for their efforts and it would also help us advertise Fermilab Friends to the broader user community. I'm imagining something like < 10 minutes.
