### **LBNC**

- The LBNC had a meeting on Thursday-Saturday (past week)
- All the slides from the meeting are available on the LBNC pages
- The meeting focused on the dual phase detector, but we were asked to give an update on the status of the electronics in a parallel session
- Report on
  - Progress with all the ASICs
  - Preparation for system tests (new FEMBs, cold box at CERN, ICEBERG)
- One recommendation (report from committee was not fact checked, it contains one error, to be fixed)
  - A full postmortem on the ICEBERG "event" should be completed and lessons learned be incorporated into procedures associated with cold electronics and chambers.

# **Preliminary Design Reviews**

- We have one preliminary design review planned for February 5-7 at CERN: ASICs and FEMBs
  - The people who should attend this review have been informed (more E-mails this week)
  - The charge for the review is available in **Indico**
  - An agenda for the review and detailed instructions for the documentation for the review will be circulated this week
  - All documentation should be made available within the consortium by January 17, we will review it and post it for the committee by January 24
  - Transparencies for the presentations should be available by January 24, finalized by January 21
- A review of the system aspects (including the WIB/PTC, power distribution, cabling) is tentatively scheduled for March 10-12

## **FNAL/DOE** reviews

- Fermilab has scheduled a director's review of the LBNF/DUNE project for April 28-May 1
- In preparation for the DOE IPR scheduled for July 14-16
- With the goal of a CD-2 review in the Fall
