



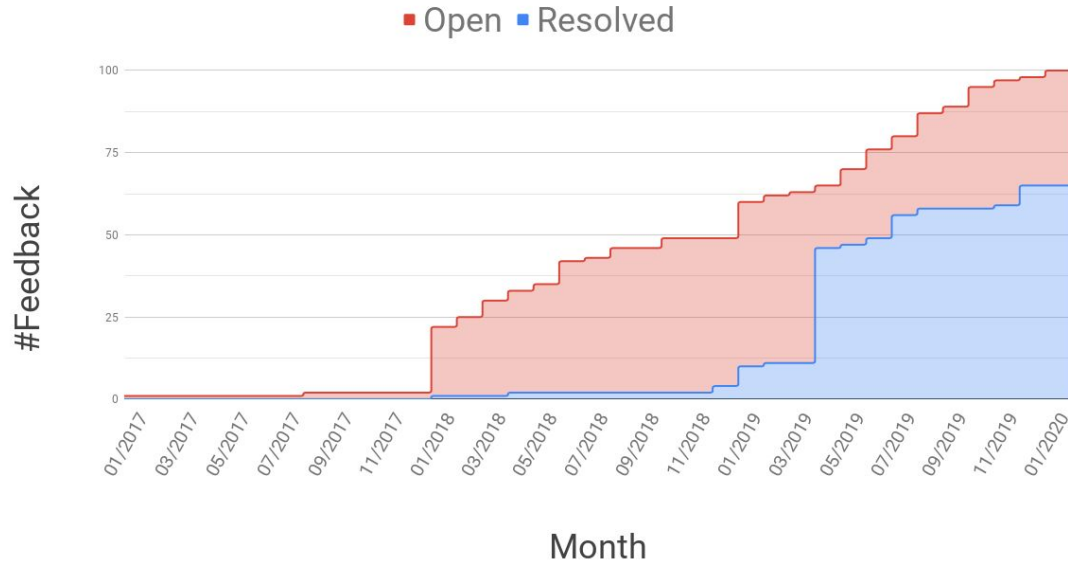

- Deciding on how to fulfill requests for houses
 - Prioritize families with children, international visitors without transportation, etc.
 - Following lab priorities (balancing neutrino, CMS, muon, theory, etc.)
 - Keeping occupancy high
- Recently decided on extension requests → all reasonable
- Dorm room allocation: 50% first-come-first-serve, 50% following lab priorities:
 - 7 rooms - International
 - 1 room -- Undergrad
 - 6 rooms -- Neutrino
 - 3 rooms -- Theory
 - 3 rooms -- CMS
 - 3 rooms -- Other (such as Astro Physics/PIP-II/SENSEI)
- General: the village cannot fulfill all requests for houses/dorm rooms in the summer months. Also we see that more requests are coming for 1 or 2 bedroom houses, while 3 bedroom houses are requested less and therefore are available more often.
