DUNE Site renaming proposal

- Currently most sites have GLIDEIN_Site values of “London”, “Manchester”, etc. that don’t conform to any particular standard or pattern
- DUNE proposes renaming them to things like “UK-Imperial”, “UK-Lancaster”, etc., and then establishing a convention like that. Makes things much easier on the APEL accounting
 - Some Sites are shared with other expts (Nova, uboone, g-2, ?)
- What are the consequences of renaming?
 - Various accounting filters would need to be changed
 - Experiments that hard-code site names would need to change
 - Anything else we’re missing?
- Worst case scenario could clone factory entries and make them DUNE-specific. More work for factory
- Are there other alternatives? GLIDEIN_Country?
