 - Reduced default disk request to 10 GB (will help to more effectively fill the slots on the new worker nodes)
- Lots of issues with low efficiency and data transfer the past few days
 - Several cases of forgetting to prestage. Should the SAM consumer skip files that are not already on disk? Error rates might go up but at least people would know what's happening
 - Also some cases where expts aren't following best practices (too many files per directory), but unclear whether that is really the root cause of slowdowns
