Activities

- Ongoing discussions with several Frontiers to identify liaisons.
- We set up bi-weekly meetings with EF TG convenors to discuss group activities and planning, e.g. overlaps of physics topics across TGs and frontiers, meeting planning etc.
- We set up multiple email lists and Slack channels (one per TG). The community is signing up to those.
- We have received request from community for <u>accessibility</u> for some meetings, namely <u>closed captioning</u>.
 - We would like to understand how APS/DPF plans to support it.
 - There are 3rd party apps which can link to zoom and provide the services in real-time (e.g. otter.ai). However we need access/permissions from university ITs (as we generally use those zoom accounts). This may also not be given due to "no live-streaming" policies to external entities (e.g. Brown U).

Activities

- Several EF TGs have started arranging meetings with their communities (one already took place last week).

- We have started forming a **MC Task Force** to identify common needs for MC samples and analysis frameworks, as well as assessing how to estimate theory uncertainties.
