## Planning the Community Planning Meeting

- Dates for the 2020 CPM determined at 3/12 all-conveners meeting
  - Wed 11/4 to Fri 11/6 at Fermilab
  - Meeting is to start in the late afternoon on 11/4, run a full day on 11/5, and end mid-afternoon 11/6
- Local organization to be led by
  - Fermilab Scientist Advisory Council (representing Fermilab staff scientists)
  - Fermilab Users Executive Committee (representing Fermilab scientific users)
- Logistics
  - Expecting a similar size (~500) meeting to the 2012 CPM
  - SAC+UEC representatives have met to start discussing the CPM
    - Leveraging UEC experience planning the (similar sized) annual Fermilab Users Meeting
  - Working with Fermilab conference office
- Goals for this month
  - Formalize local organizing committee
  - Start designing Indico pages (Fermilab Indico will be upgraded this weekend)



## **COVID19** and remote access

- No crystal ball but safe to assume that COVID19 will still be an issue by Nov
  - Even in the case of an in-person meeting, expect that a significant fraction of attendance would be remote
    - Ensuring that all meeting rooms are properly connected
    - Ensuring that all sessions are recorded
  - Prepared to switch to an all-virtual meeting if necessary
    - Learning from experiences of large conferences/meetings that have virtualized
  - Frontier conveners will need to take remote participation into account when planning the meeting agenda
- We will follow DPF, FNAL, DOE, IL, and CDC guidance
  - IL currently under shelter-in-place until May 30
    - Fermilab remote-only apart from safety-related operations until then
  - CPM LOC is in close contact with FNAL directorate on laboratory plans re:COVID



## **Needs from the Snowmass community**

- Planning the meeting agenda
  - Point(s) of contact for scientific planning would be helpful (a subset of the FCs?)
- We invite the summer study organizers to "join" the CPM LOC
  - Mainly so that they can learn from our mistakes
- Schedule planning
  - Everything discussed assumes the original dates of 11/4-11/6
  - Should the entire Snowmass process be delayed, we would work to reschedule the CPM as appropriate
