# Fermilab Access Control Policy

- Significant changes were proposed to Fermilab policy for access control in December
  - Wording of changes would have significant impact on Daughters & Sons to Work Day and completely prohibit minors from WH ground floor email room
  - Open comment period ended in late December & produced a significant number of suggestions...
- Nancy Grossman helped rewrite policy, based on comments from users at the lab
  - Draft options/questions now being considered by directorate
  - A 2<sup>nd</sup> round of comments will take place for new draft



# Meeting with Bruce Chrisman (Jan 26<sup>th</sup>)

- Budget impact on QoL programs at the lab still unknown, but things will move fast once a budget exists
  - Directorate does not want to repeat something like the "surprise pool closure proposal," and is interested in involving the UEC early as the plans are formed

  - Directorate plans on sharing details about proposed changes that may affect Users with the UEC at some point during the planning process in order to get our feedback
