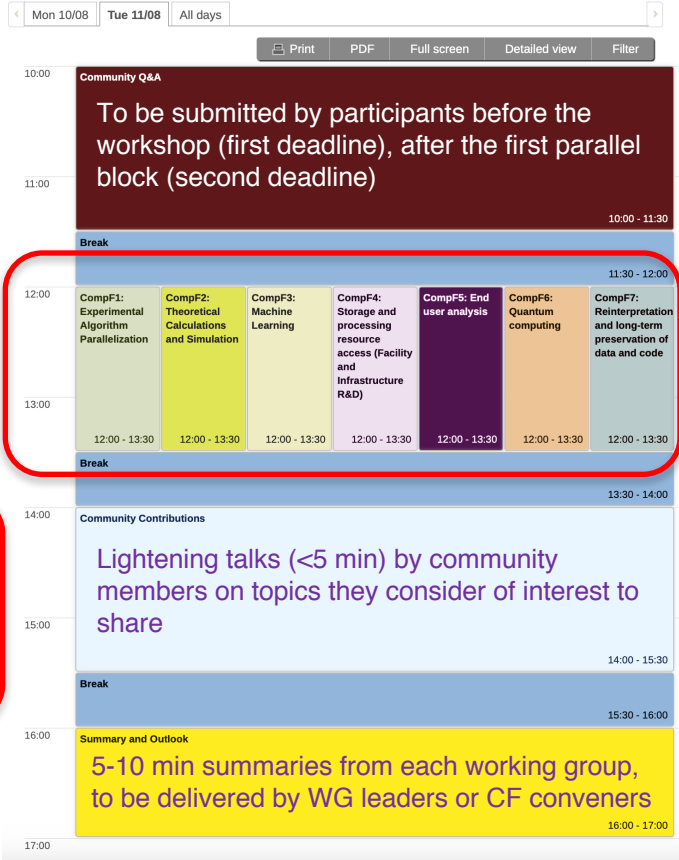
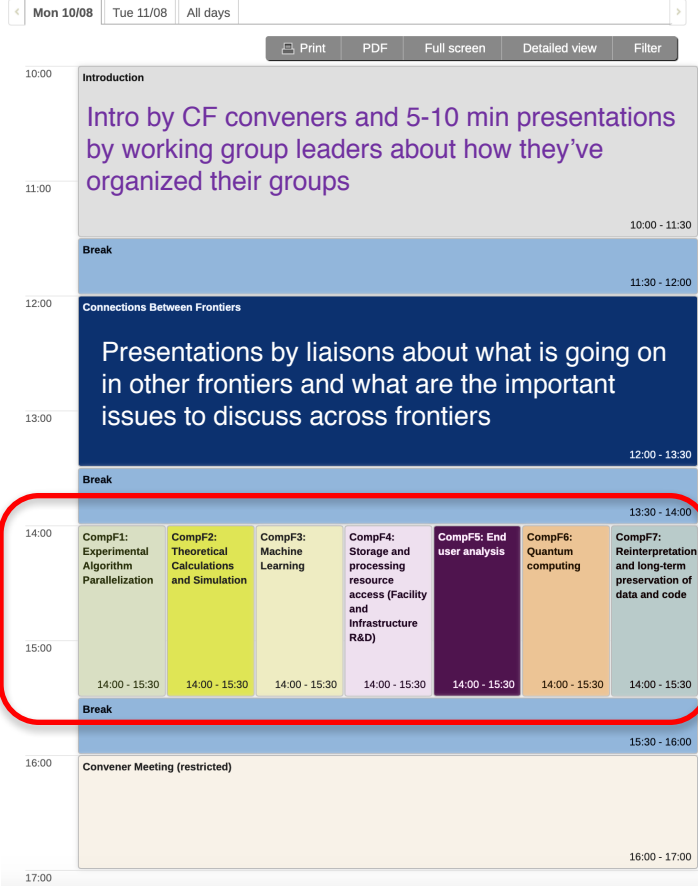
Towards the Letters Of Interest (LOIs)
