 - September?



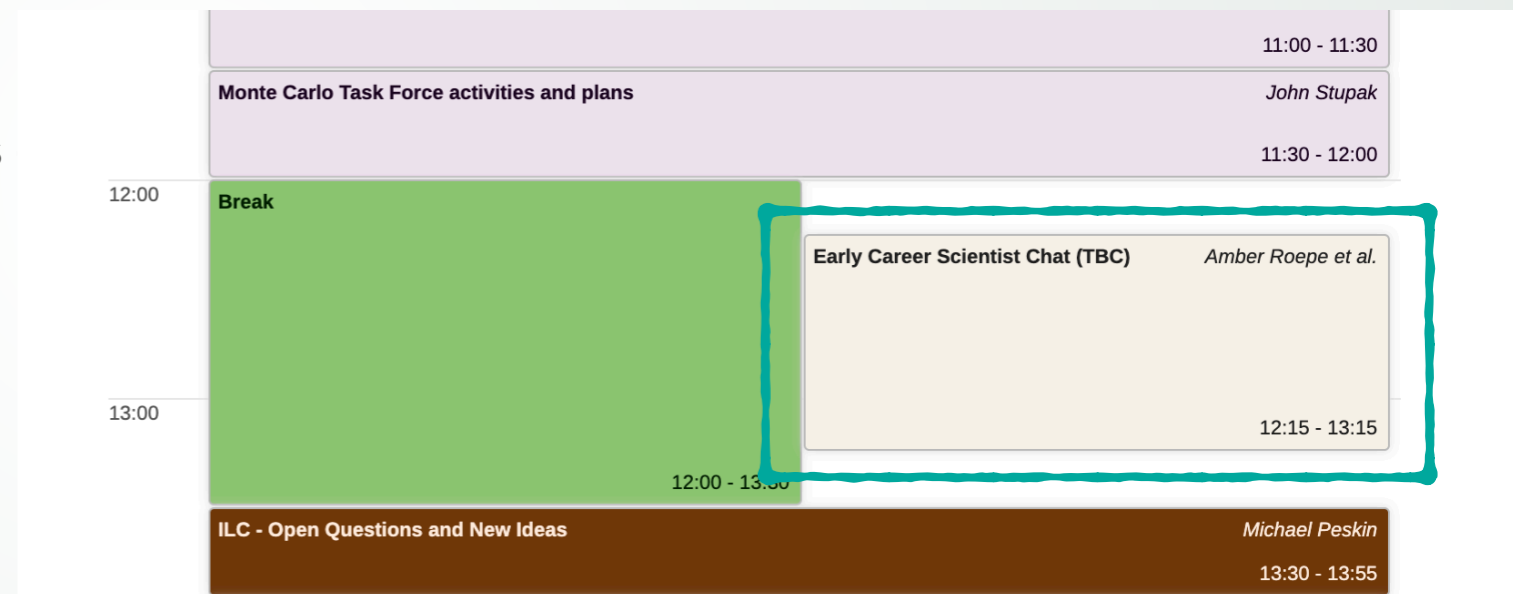
Muon Collider
