- Last Wednesday, we had our first SEC-NF meeting after CPM.
- Discussed CPM experience of SEC-NF members:
 - Overall CPM was interesting and inspiring. Plenary sessions were nice.
 - Breakout sessions were not easy to navigate but they were probably as well organized as practically possible.
 - NF's customized spreadsheet was useful in navigating breakout sessions.
 - Often had to choose between multiple sessions of interest that were happening at the same time.
 - About involvement of SEC-NF members in the CPM: general feeling was that CPM tended to be high-level discussion from senior people, EC members didn't have many opportunities to participate.
 - Perhaps, workshops are places to have more engaged discussion and more involvement of EC members. A good example was the pre-CPM TF11 <u>mini-workshop</u>, which had strong participation from EC members.

- Discussion on the scope of SEC-NF group/meetings post-LOI/post-CPM:
 - Some members present at the meeting were generally planning to be somewhat less heavily involved in Snowmass for the next few months.
 - Some are active with topical groups in helping to plan workshops and/or in whitepaper developments.
 - We are planning to run a poll among SEC-NF members to plan meeting frequency/possible activities of interests:
 - Organizing workshops: on analysis tools, etc., and/or for career development perhaps in coordination with SEC-Inreach group
 - Journal club: inviting members to present their research, Snowmass involvement, etc.
