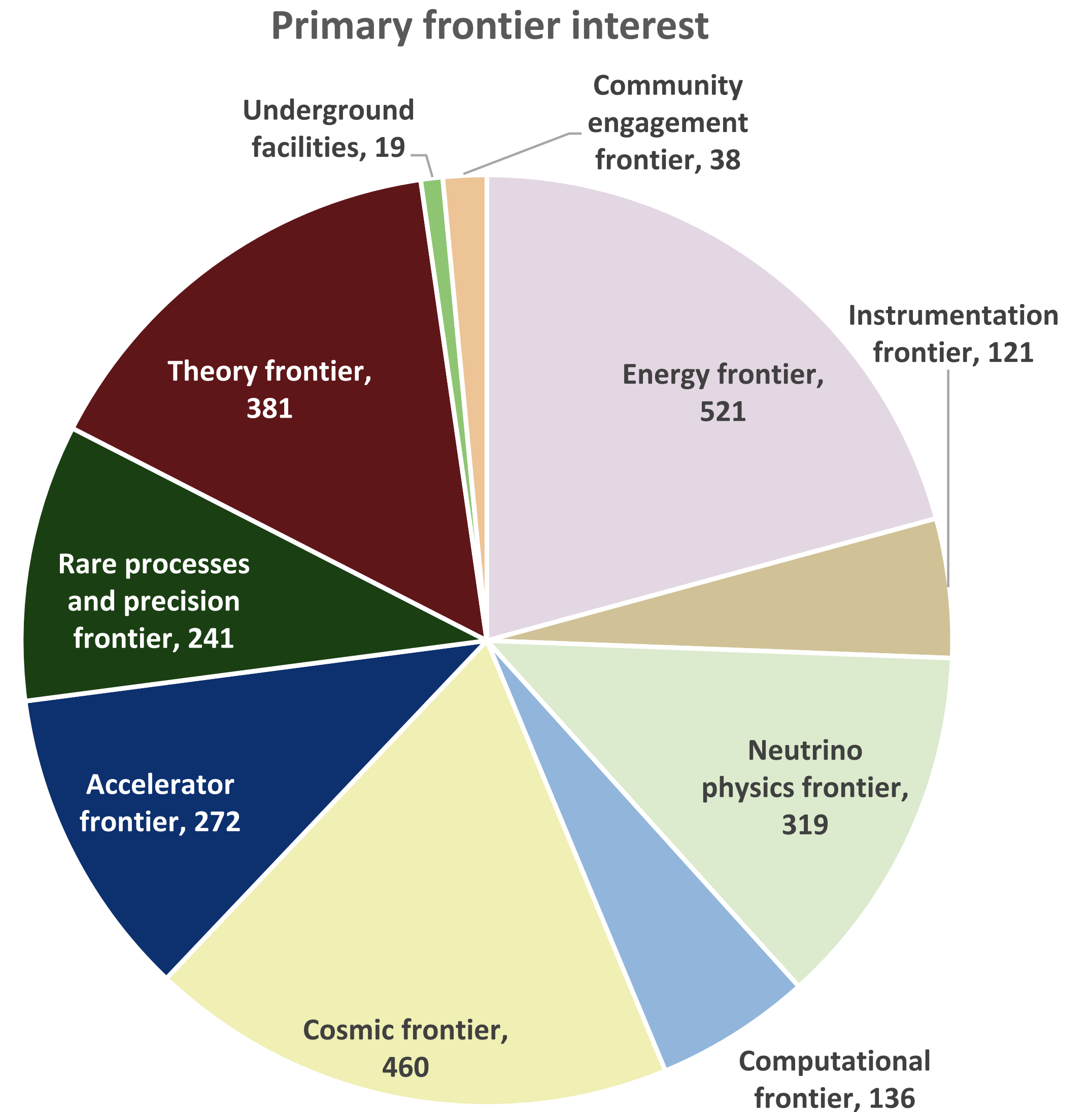
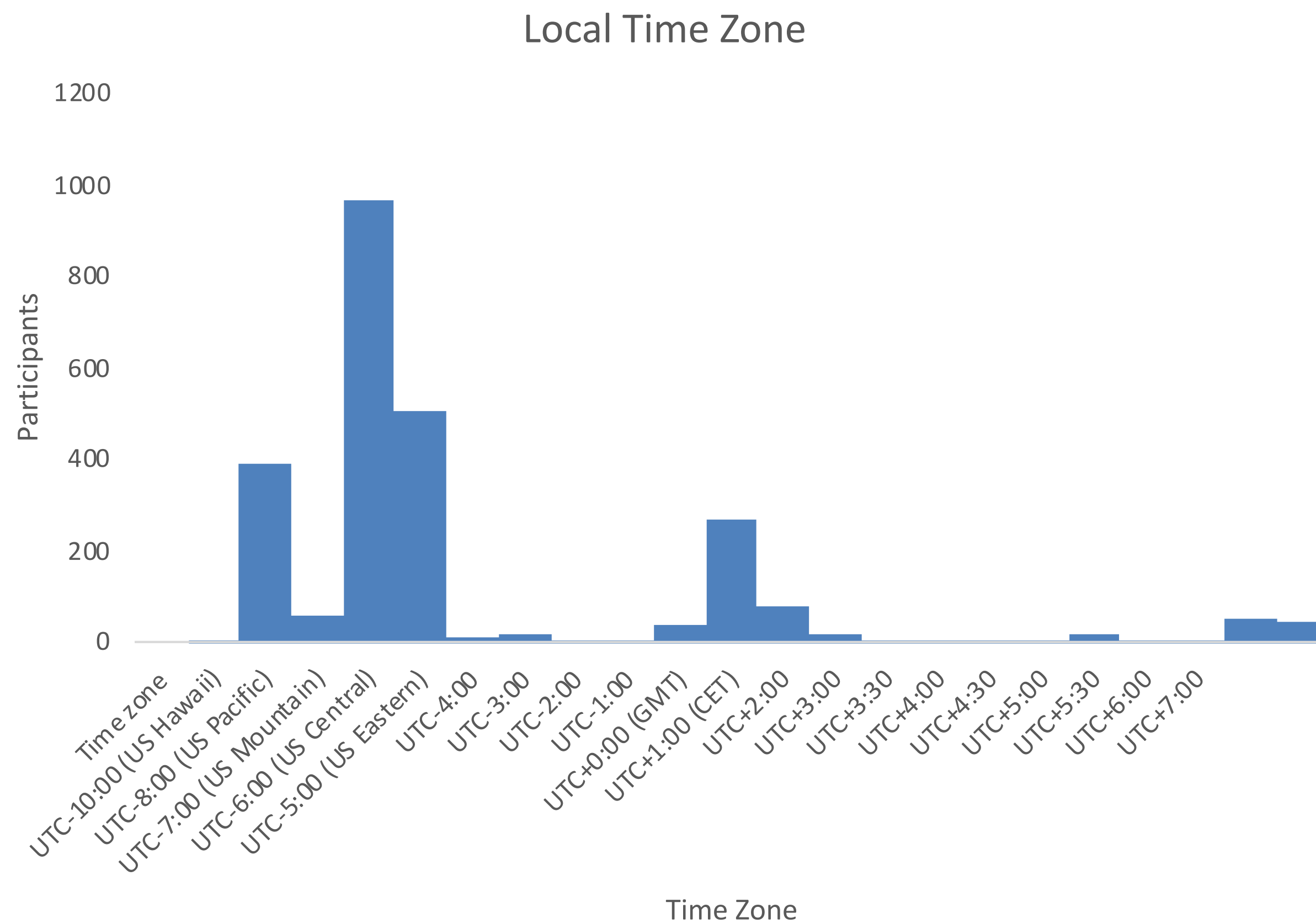

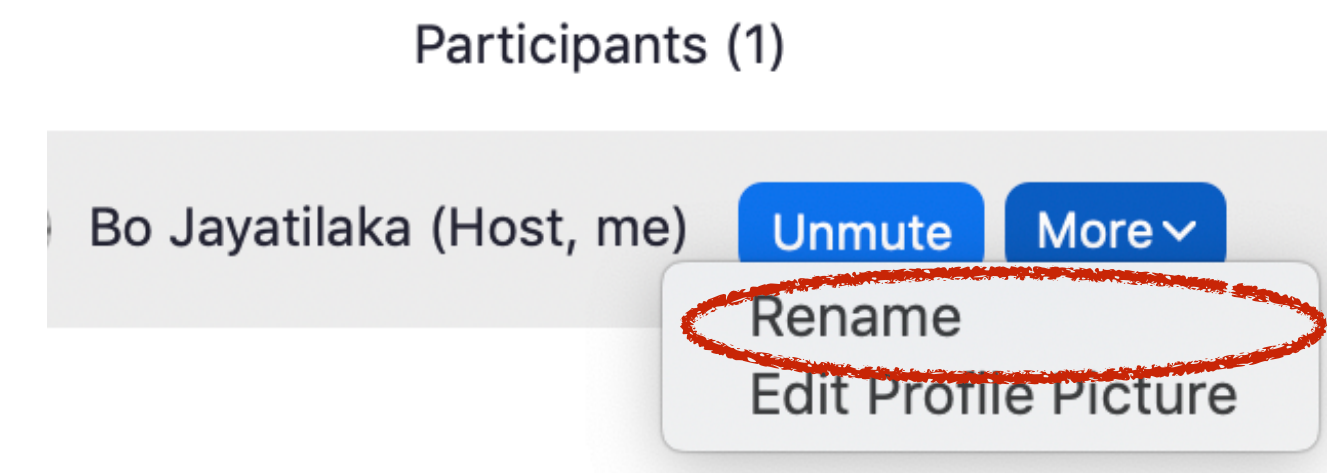


DPF Core Principles and Community Guidelines (CP&CG)

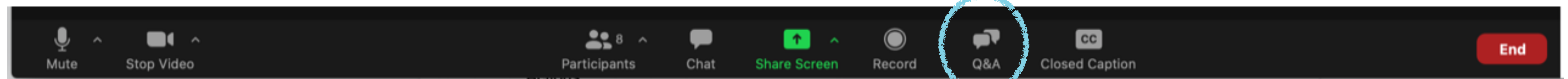
- Make use of the CPM-dedicated channels on the Snowmass **Slack**

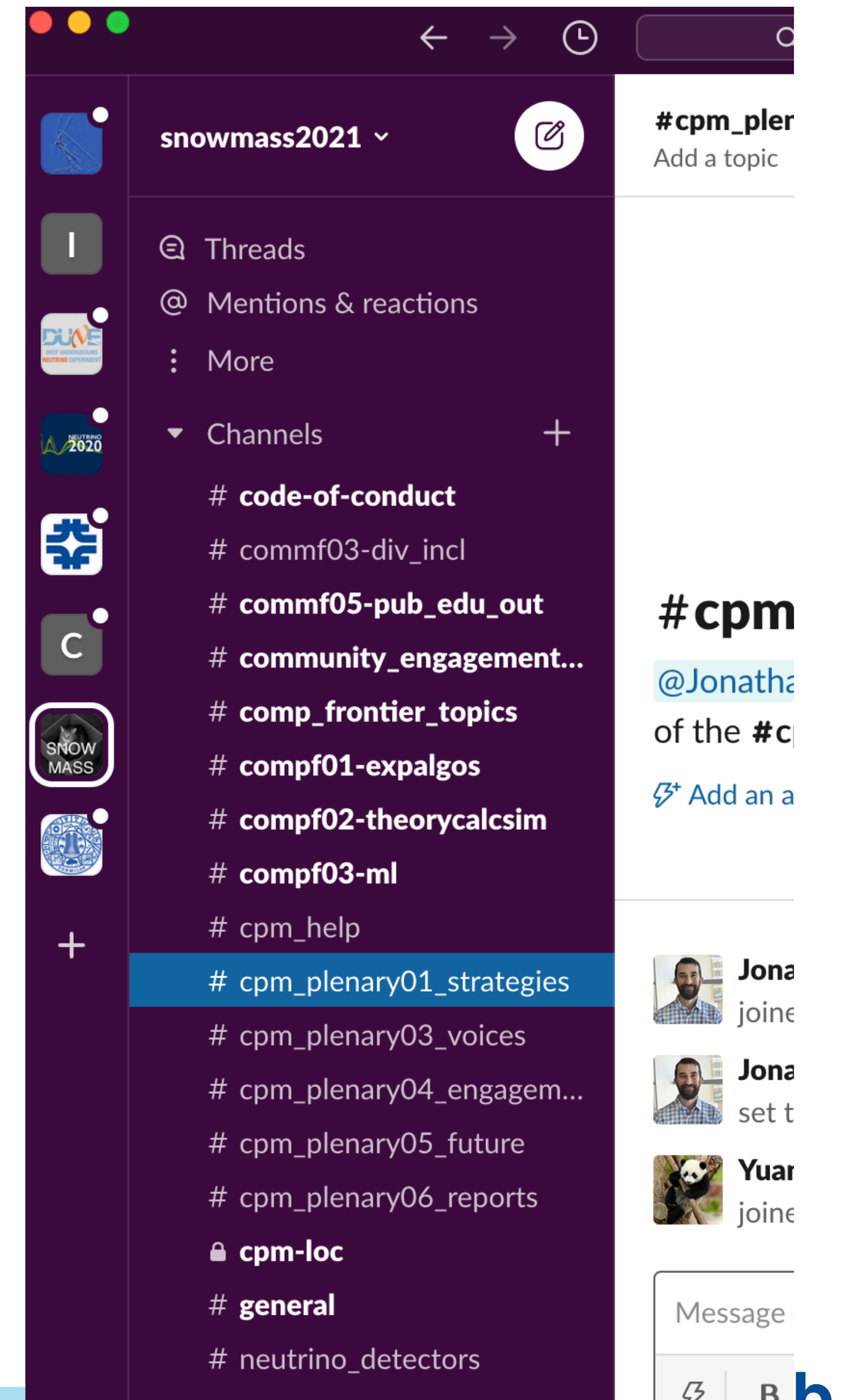

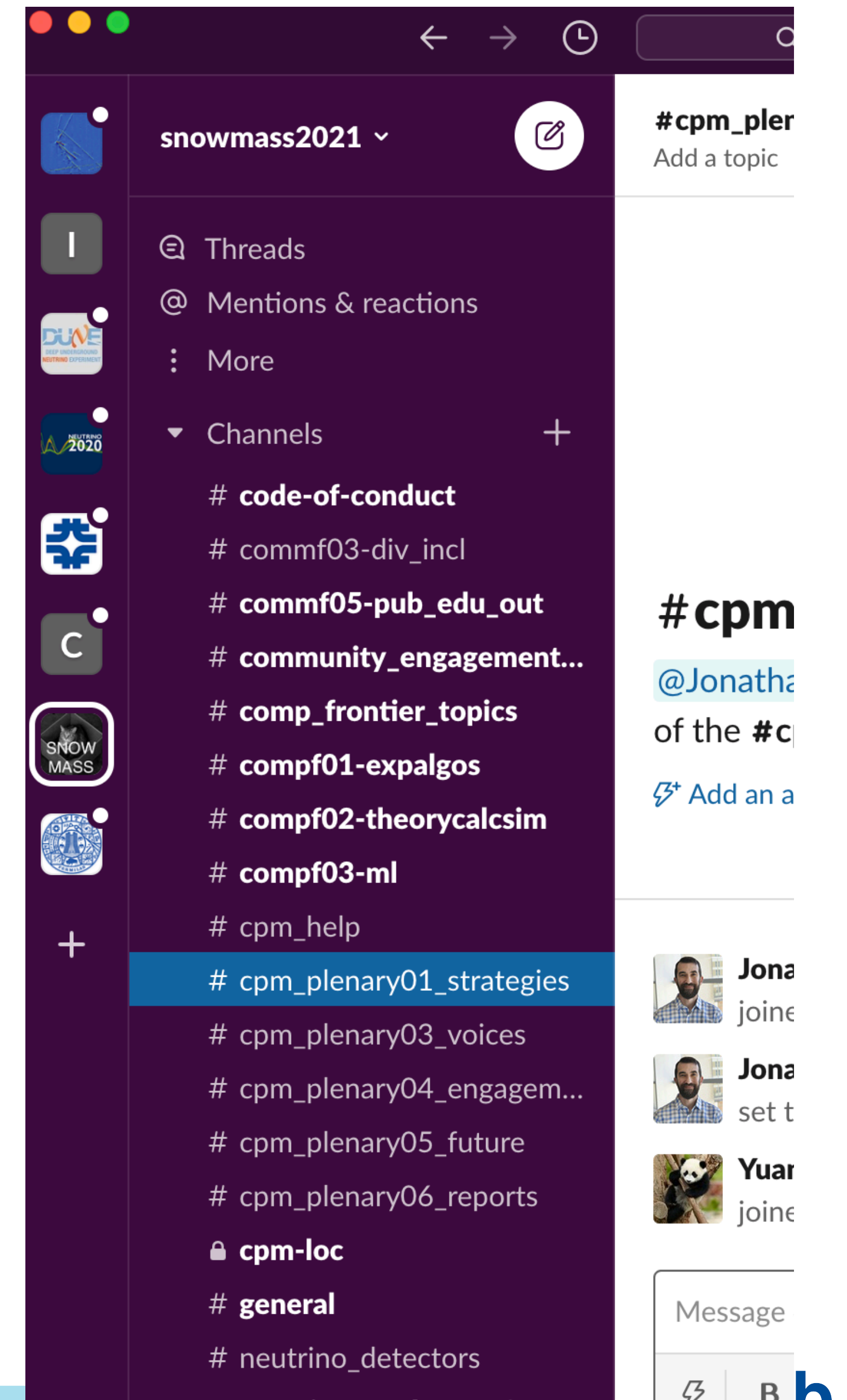
