## **CPM** updates

- Registration/costs
  - FRA funds can be used to cover expenses such as captioning/accessibility services
    - Estimate that \$5k will be available for the CPM
  - Conference office assisting with Indico page/registration
    - Anticipate being completed this week
  - Do not anticipate needing a registration fee
- Accessibility
  - Evaluating several options for captioning (PowerPoint and Otter.ai)
- Zoom/videoconferencing
  - Fermilab has two Zoom webinar licenses
    - Allow for up to 5000 participants (watching) and 100 "panelists" (speaking)
    - Does not have breakouts
  - Additionally has one "large meeting" Zoom room (up to 1000 participants)
    - Meeting rooms started by Fermilab staff can have up to 300 participants
    - Zoom rooms can have a total of 50 breakouts each
  - No cost associated with using these for CPM



## Meeting "room" proposal

- Plenary sessions be held in webinar form
  - Allows for individual speakers and panel-type fora
  - Regular participants not allowed to use audio or chat
  - Questions can be asked via Q&A (handled by moderator) or through Slack (or other platform)
    - This format was used for plenary sessions at Neutrino 2020
- Breakout/parallel sessions be held in parallel "meeting rooms"
  - Can have one up to 1k room and multiple up to 300 person rooms
  - Conveners can sign up for meeting rooms for given times
    - Breakouts can be managed within each meeting room
  - Ad-hoc meeting rooms can also be created and assigned if pre-assigned meeting rooms prove insufficient
