Nature of LOI Feedback

From Marina email:

As we move forward, should we advise contributed papers on physics programs? Is it our consensus that the main text of the final report should encompass the important physics topics on a global scale, but the contributed papers should highlight US initiatives? (for example US people do not work on the angle gamma, critical to the CKM test. Clearly we have to include all the relevant physics of LHCb in any performance comparisons. There are relevant examples for each TG.) Is there a common consensus and should we convey that to the authors?

- Snowmass is not supposed to produce a bunch of intellectually stapled-together reports. Our job is to create an overall picture in each TG and then the Frontier.
 - Should we have guidelines for contributed papers to help that?
- We need to come up with a concrete plan for managing LOIs and the next 9-10 months
 - hard to do without having LOIs but we have some ideas about what is coming in
