Agenda: Finalize the Snowmass Delay Plans



## A few remarks:

- Our Snowmass frontiers span over broad topics, disciplines, demography. So our delay process must seek for a common ground of all.
- When encountering different deadline preferences, we should be accommodative and adopt the “less restrictive” ones.
- “Pause/slowdown” refer to Snowmass-organized activities, nothing about your regular work.
- 7 frontiers prefer a “pause”: CF, CompF, IF, RPF, NF, TF & UF
- 3 frontier + SEC prefer a “slowdown”: AF, EF, CEF & SEC

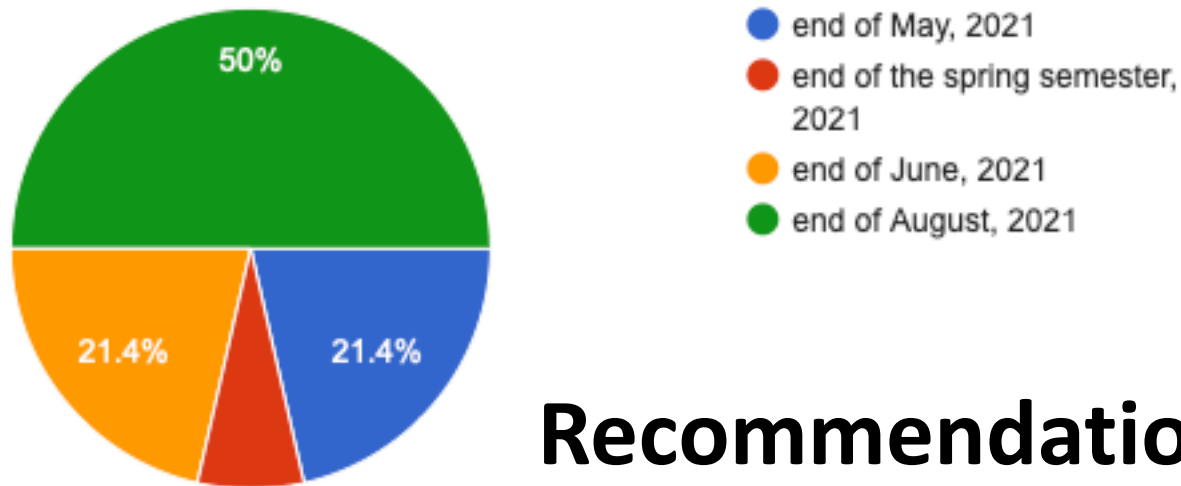
# What we would not do: the “Pause”

High-level activities will be on hold. These activities include: Frontier-level and **Topical Group-level** workshops, All-conveners meetings, Advisory Group meetings and Newsletters.

## The timeline for the pause:

All-frontier activities on hold till

14 responses



Some observations:

- We added TG workshops, now more restrictive!
- August more restrictive: may not leave enough time for the White paper preparation (end of the year, holidays...)

**Recommendation: end of June, 2021**

# What we can do: “slowdown” before the end of June, 2021

- Snowmass community self-organizing, topical group and cross-frontier activities should be reduced to the minimum and continue only if necessary to ensure scientific continuity, programmatic needs and collaborative work with other units.
- Individual and collaborative work can continue at the discretion of the individuals involved.

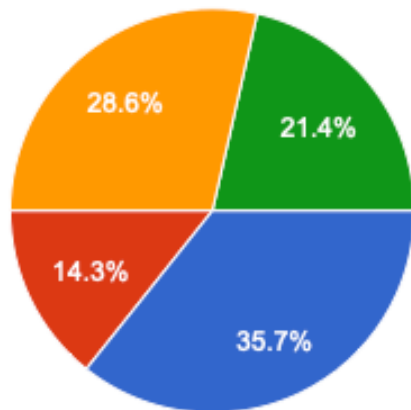

- Late submissions/updates **are likely not to be incorporated** in the convener's reports, but will be included in the final Snowmass online archive documents.

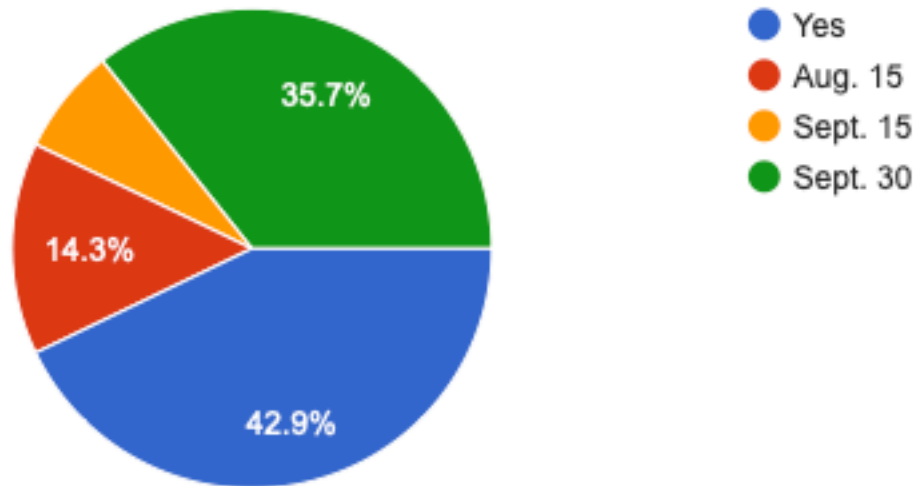

Final Frontier reports/TG reports due August 31, 2022

Original plan on August 31: easy for Steering Group/P5 ...

But: **August is a “dead zone”:**

- Conflict meetings;
- End of summer/new semester activities...

**Recommendation: September 30, 2022**

# Other deadlines are mostly agreeable:

- Deadline for preliminary reports by the Topical Groups: **May 31, 2022.**
- Deadline for preliminary reports by the Frontiers: **June 30, 2022.**
- Snowmass Community Summer Study (CSS): **July, 2022 at UW-Seattle.**
- Snowmass Book and the on-line archive documents due: **October 31, 2022.**

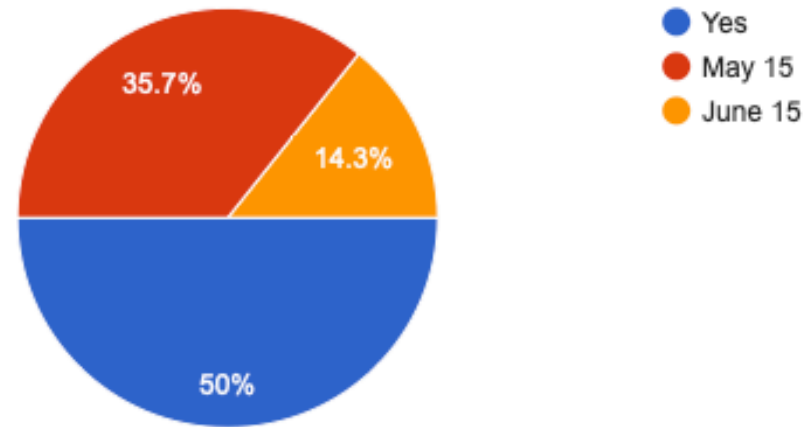
# Other related events (TBD)
