

The conclusion of the Users Meeting, usually marks the start of the Nominations/Elections process. Remember UEC terms are ending in September for:

#### Policy 7: SubCommittee Chair Policy, adopted on June 14, 2019


- 1. SC chairs are voted into office with a simple majority of the UEC membership.
- 2. Deputy SC Chairs are appointed by the relevant SC Chair.
- 3. To ensure continuity in the Government Relations and Users Meeting subcommittees:
  - a. The candidate(s) for Deputy SC Chair is(are) nominated by the current SC Chair and ratified by a simple majority of the UEC membership
  - b. The appointment is for two years: the elected person will serve one year as Deputy SC Chair, followed by one year as SC Chair.
  - c. The annual Users Meeting will mark the start of an overlap period between the outgoing and incoming SC Chair, during which time the SC Deputy Chair will transition into the role of SC Chair. The overlap period ends when a new SC Deputy Chair is elected.

Goal is to have new members elected by end of September. First meeting with new members is usually October. (Last year we were late!)

- Get our website (and public minutes) up to date!


