
The Awakening of Topical Group RF7 Hadron Spectroscopy

When we last met on 22 January...

- RF7 had finished a series of workshops, culminating with a joint EF06/RF7 meeting on 16 December
- We had focused the white paper submissions relevant to RF7 down to **13** (see next slide)
- Our own Subtopic Conveners are authors on 11 of them! Won't be difficult to delegate responsibility for organizing individual writing tasks
- Hadronic spectroscopy currently centered around just a few current experiments, a few experiments under construction/prospective, and a few theoretical approaches
