#### **OSG 3.5 Retirement**

- Starting in September, **OSG 3.5 only gets critical bug and security fixes** until its planned retirement in February 2022
- OSG 3.5 contains software that supports both X.509 proxies and bearer tokens OSG 3.5 will continue to receive critical bug fixes to ensure a smooth transition to a fully token-based authentication and authorization infrastructure
- OSG is holding the **Token Transition Workshop October** 14th and 15th with the purpose of providing "an opportunity for system and service administrators in the broader science communities to learn more about making the transition from certificates to tokens for resource access within your organization's infrastructure".

### Token Task Force for non-CMS Experiments

- We will be moving from X.509 certificates to access tokens for authentication in the not-too-distant future
- For **seamless changeover**, we need to think beforehand about requirements and possible issues that could arise, e.g storage access layout (how experiments grant their users access)
- We have formed a **task force** to this end consisting of a representative from each of the larger experiments at the lab (Dune, g-2, Nova, Mu2e, Minerva, SBN experiments, and DES) and several CD folks



#### **Progress of Token Task Force**

- One meeting thus far on Tuesday, September 7th (managed to get a large majority of the 12 people there an impressive feat on its own)
- Second meeting is scheduled for next Wednesday at 1pm () Marc M and Dmitry will be attending
  in order to address many questions that came up in our last meeting
- Token Issuers set up for Dune, DES, gm2, Mu2e and SBND and dCache has been configured for these VOs
- Experimental reps have been given instructions on the basics of tokens: how to get one, how to access storage with one, automated usage of tokens from cron
- Some testing has been done already and a flurry of emails has ensued!
- FIFE will soon have a mediawiki site that will contain all of the documents related to this Task Force
