Turning Motivating Town Halls into CPs

- Need to document observations and suggestions from each Town Hall dedicated to demographic groups
 - How to take information from THs -> CP?
 - Need person power to manage 'study groups'
- Connections beyond physics (i.e. social sciences, education)
 - Panel discussions are much more rich with experts from fields relating to topics covered
 - Need folks who are aware of experts (or how to find them) in these fields to coordinate with TH organizers to enrich panels, as well as the WP to come from the discussions

- -- Indico Category (<u>link</u>): Black, LGBTQIA+, Womxn, Ethnoracial D&I, Obstacles for AAIP folks, Early-Career, Accessibility
- -- In addition to related THs: Mental Health, Work/Life Balance, Mentoring, Societal Impacts of Science Projects, Code of Conduct

- -- Started with 'study group' from AAIP TH, but need to do all
- -- AND connect between groups: we share a lot and can learn from each other
