Progress of Token Task Force

- Scope has expanded from discussions with experimental representatives to include service providers.
- We have had three meetings thus far. Most recently, Dave and Mine gave a talk on Token Authentication Background (the why's and how's of tokens)
- Token Issuers have been set up for Dune, DES, gm2, Mu2e and SBND - dCache has been configured for these VOs
- Experimental reps have been given instructions on the basics of tokens: how to get one, how to access storage with one, automated usage of tokens from cron
- Initial testing has been done
