Welcome to Sheffield!

- The 3rd most populous 'district' in England
- 61% of Sheffield's entire area is green space
 - The city has four trees for every person
- It hosts the world's oldest football club
 - Sheffield FC was founded in 1857 by members of a cricket club
- The area where Sheffield sits has been inhabited since approximately 9,000 BC
- In 2012, it hosted the highest number of people tossing pancakes in the world (890)

There's a slide at the end with a map.

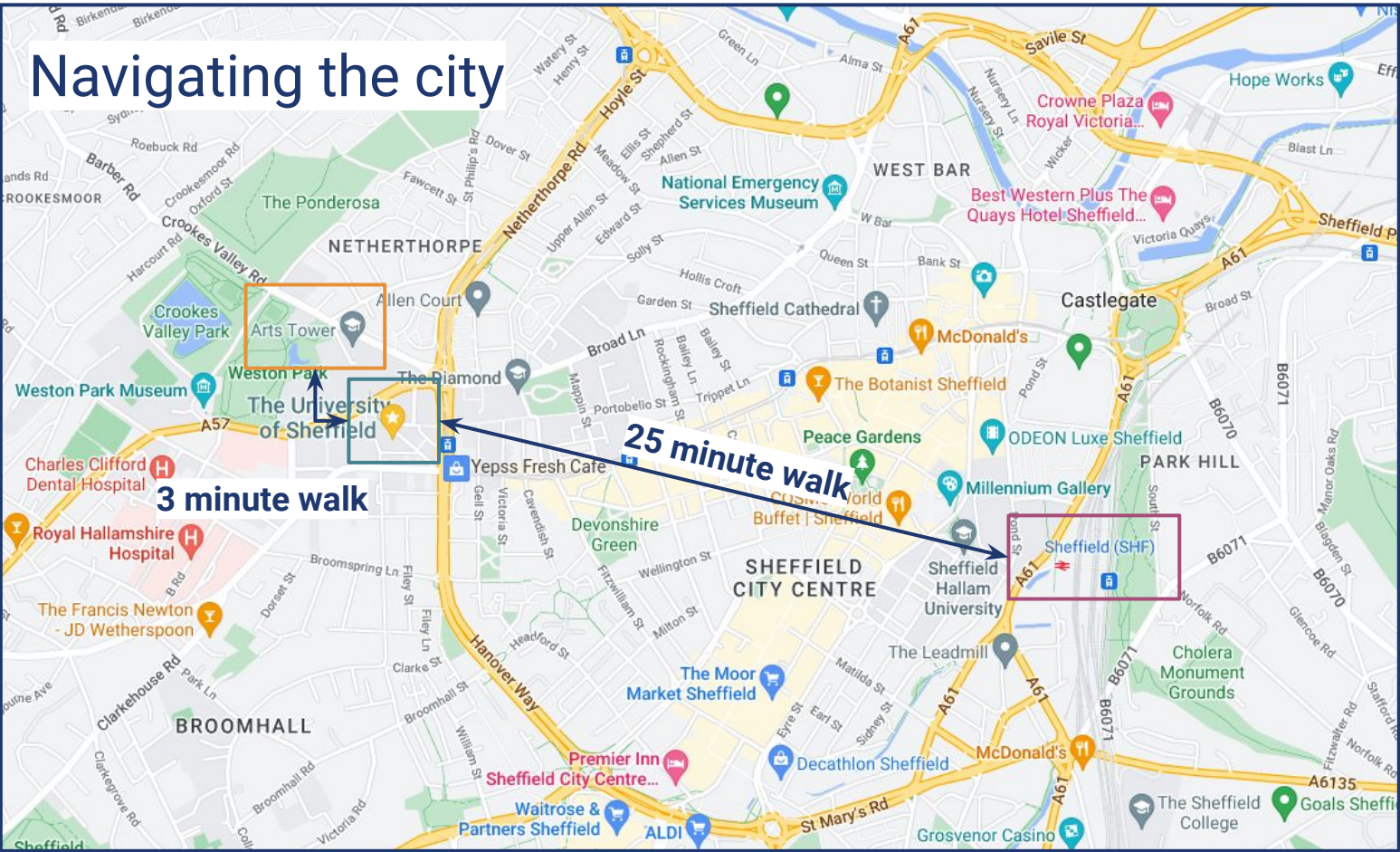
