

Quasielastic scattering with the Relativistic Green Function approach

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♥ : we are interested in a consistent description of FSI in exclusive and inclusive reactions

♠ : relativistic models for electron and neutrino-nucleus scattering

◇ : Relativistic Green's Function

♣ : **RGF**: matrix elements of the same type as usual RDWIA models, but eigenfunctions of both \mathcal{V} and \mathcal{V}^\dagger are involved \implies the imaginary part of the optical potential is very important \implies RGF very different from models like rROP

♥ : good results for the (e, e') cross section

♠ : results for the CCQE and NCE cross sections from MiniBooNE \implies reasonable agreement with data

◇ : possible contribution of reaction channels that are recovered by the imaginary part of the optical potential even if they are not included in the model
