Criteria:

- demonstration of need

Priorities:

- Early Career members who do not have other funding for the conference.
- Applicants who are actively involved in the Snowmass organization process
- Applicants who are presenting at the conference (talk or poster)
- Members of underrepresented groups (women and underrepresented minorities)

Minimum Amounts (depending on the number of applications): \$300 for virtual conference registration fee \$300 for domestic travel and conference registration fee \$500 for international travel and conference registration fee

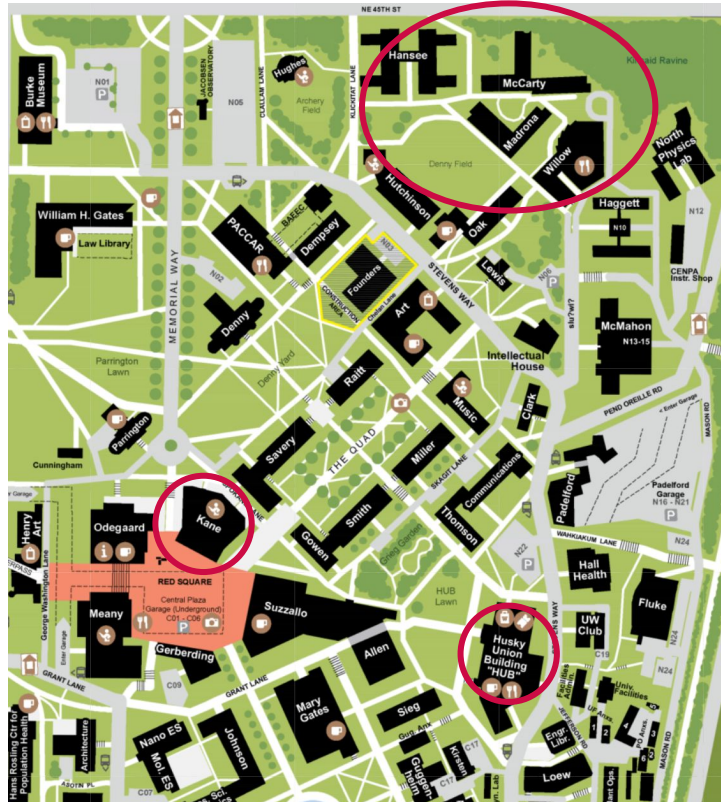


Other Options

Dorms



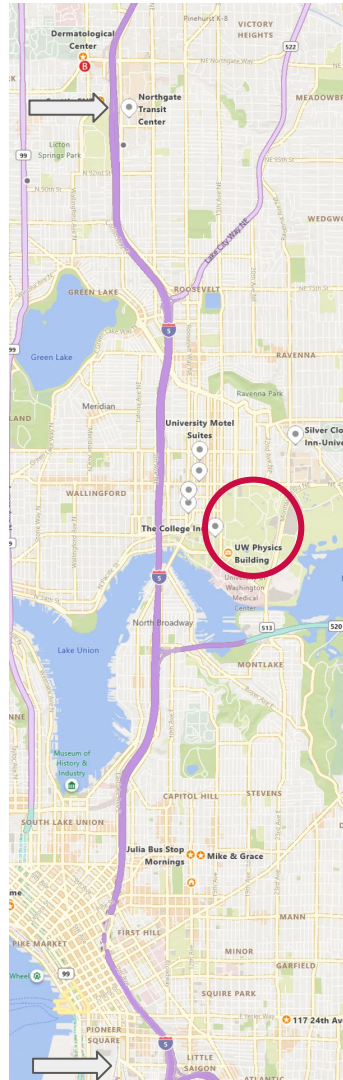
Dorm Rooms
