


Total number of participants: 777

Based on ICHEP model

1-Week-Before (send this on July 10th)

- Any logistics (including COVID general information)
- Zoom Links for all

All but zoom links will be mirrored to slack

Will Need Help

Important Meetings

- Can be filled out long before actual meeting
- Have parallels recommend by per-frontier
- Have a short blurb on each afternoon - “why you want to come”
- Will need everyone’s help for this

Highlights From Previous Day
