Financial Status

- Current (8/31) financial status: ~164 K
- Still waiting for University of Washington to charge for Snowmass travel awards, registration subsidy (~40K)...

Membership count

- Latest count (mid-November): 3004
- Approx. unchanged since August
- Count was ~3400-3500 for 2018-2021
 - 1/31/22: 3488
 - 4/1/22 : 3165
 - 8/1/22 : 3029
 - 10/4/22: 2933
 - 11/10/22: 3004
- Would like APS to reach out to members whose membership lapsed and invite them to re-join DPF.
 - Would like to offer 1 year of DPF membership for free i.e. not charge the \$10 (APS suggestion)
 - Comments/concerns?

DPF election

- Voting is on and will run until December 10th.
- About 16% of the membership has voted so far
- A reminder to vote will be sent around Dec 1
- What fraction of the membership has voted in recent years?
 - I know that in 2018, about 21.63% of the membership voted.
 - Just checked with APS regarding their experience with other units and historical DPF info

 - APS appears to be interested in pursuing this since they've asked me several questions in the meantime –the domain/url, how many people, whether they are DPF members or not etc.
