

Dear Colleagues,

Lattice 2023 will be held at Fermilab, outside Chicago, from July 30 - August 5. We look forward to a stimulating scientific program and social activities at Fermilab and downtown Chicago, but before the official program announcement we wanted to share a logistical update on the conference registration process.

Anyone who does not already have a Fermilab visitor badge (that will not have expired by the time of the conference) will have to fill out a brief online form in order to request Fermilab site access before registering for the conference. The process for requesting site access has recently been streamlined to support conferences such as Lattice 2023, and it should now take about 6 weeks to be granted site access. Note that registration fee payment will not be due until after your site access request has been approved.

Those of you who need a visa to enter the US are encouraged to begin the visa process as soon as possible. You can obtain the invitation letter you may need for this process by filling out the brief online form at this link: <https://indico.fnal.gov/event/57249/registrations/3578/>
