Second Bulletin of the 40th International Symposium on Lattice Field Theory (Lattice 2023)

Lattice 2023 is being hosted by Fermilab in partnership with other Chicago area institutions: Argonne National Lab, The University of Illinois Chicago, and The University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign. The conference will take place from Monday July 31 to Friday August 5 at Fermilab in Batavia, IL.

PROGRAM

The schedule of plenary and parallel talk sessions can be found on the Indico timetable. There will be no talks on Saturday in order to accommodate personal obligations that participants may have over the weekend. A few special events will be held during the week:

- A welcome reception Monday evening, held at Fermilab shortly after the last afternoon parallel talk session.
- The poster session will be held Tuesday evening at Fermilab and include light dinner and refreshments.
- The conference excursion will be to downtown Chicago on Wednesday afternoon and include an architectural boat tour pointing out the sights and some of the history of Chicago. Buses will transport interested participants between Fermilab and downtown.

VISITING FERMILAB

If you are considering attending Lattice 2023, we request that you please fill out the Fermilab Visitor Form soon to be available on the Indico registration page at your earliest convenience. This will initiate Fermilab's visitor approval process, which can take 6-8 weeks to be completed. You must be an approved Fermilab Visitor for both physical and virtual conference access.

Several hotels conveniently located close to Fermilab are listed on the Indico page. If there is demand, we will run buses from the Hampton Inn Naperville (with walking distance of several other hotels and restaurants, see location here https://www.google.com/maps/@41.8038542,-88.1301945,17z) to Fermilab in the morning and returning to these hotels after each day's events. Other hotels offer complementary shuttle service, as indicated on the hotels/ logistics tab of the Indico page along with further details on getting to and from conference events.

REMOTE PARTICIPATION

There will be a remote participation option available with a reduced registration fee to offset the part of the costs of streaming talks. We hope that this remote option will broaden participation, though we encourage in-person attendance where circumstances permit in order to promote a vibrant conference atmosphere. Note that — even if you are planning to attend virtually — you still need to complete the Fermilab Visitor Form discussed above.

Note that payment will not be due until after your Fermilab access has been approved. You will receive a personalized link to PayPal. The final deadline for payment is July 14, 2023.
