Safety

We need everyone to go home safely, without injury. Please prioritize protecting yourself and your colleagues

- It's important to slow down or stop to address safety concerns.
 - If someone is concerned or confused, take the time to pause and work through the issue.
 - If needed, update the work plan and seek approvals.
 - Nobody should give anyone a hard time for slowing down for these reasons
- Psychological Safety
 - Psychological safety is the belief that it's OK to take interpersonal risks without fear of undue consequences. In a psychologically safe environment, people are more likely to speak up when they see their team or organization heading down the wrong path. They're more likely to brainstorm and experiment in ways that help teams innovate, and they're less likely to go along with risky behaviors that create an unsafe workplace. Psychological safety allows a person to be themselves, which strengthens morale, sense of belonging, and employee retention.
 - Psychological safety is the belief that you won't be punished or humiliated for speaking up with ideas, questions, concerns, or mistakes.



Recent Safety Incidents

- 4/19/2023 First Aid, Batavia The employee was using a drill press to cut a hole in a thin piece of stainless steel. They were holding the piece of metal in place with their bare hand. When the drill press started to make the hole in the metal, the metal quickly rotated and cut the employee's left thumb. The employee received first aid at the Fermilab medical office. It is recommended to utilize a vise to hold materials in place while using the drill press.
- •4/25/2023 First Aid, Batavia An employee was soldering connectors onto a magnet that was already positioned on a stand. Since the magnet was already placed on the stand it caused an awkward posture and position. As they were holding the solder wire with the left hand and the soldering iron with the right, they lost grip on the iron causing it to fall and contact the left thumb causing a burn. First aid provided by the Fermi Occupational Medical Office.



ORPS - February 15, 2023 - April 4, 2023

 During a walkthrough of Lab 5, the injection molding machine was discovered with multiple panels open.
 The breaker at the 480V distribution panel that feeds the machine was still on and not locked out. The breaker on the front of the machine was off, but not locked out.

Immediate actions:

- Upon discovery, ESH personnel were requested to the site.
 The Electrical Safety Officer locked out the panel to put the machine into a safe, controlled state.
- The Associate Lab Director for Particle Physics implemented a work pause on the machine until the event review could be completed.
- An event review team was identified and completed factfinding activities. Causal analysis is underway.

Effective May 8, 2023, the PRT is REQUIRED for all PPD-initiated purchases

- · Standardizes the request format
- · Outlines the purchasing flow
- · Color-coded to identify what information is required
 - Color coding applies to data entry fields too
- Embeds multiple attachments into one file, allows for electronic signatures
 - PF-18
 - New Sole Source
 - · Computer Justification

- ALWAYS go to the SharePoint site and DOWNLOAD THE MOST RECENT VERSION OF THE PRT
- Use Excel or Google Sheets to edit the PRT
 - If you choose Google: do not convert the file to a Google Sheet keep the PRT in .xlsx format
 - Do not use a freeware program or app to edit the PRT

 The preferred format for approvals for any requisition is:

- Vendor Name
- 2. Project/Task
- Approval from owner of P/T for the order.
- Please remember to hide those tabs of the template not being used.
- Once the form is filled out, please send to Sonya+Cathy

Housing

- Summer housing requests were processed April 20th
- It seems that due to limited supply, housing is mostly unavailable for the summer
- The lab is working to provide housing advice to people, possibly with our negotiated rates with nearby folks
- Please make sure that if you have people visiting they prepare housing in advance, as the dorms are not going to be a convenient option
- Andrei manages the Mu2e Housing, Chris manages g-2 housing.
 - If there are open rooms in these houses and extra Muon department demand, we should utilize the space
 - Note: all Mu2e house spots are booked through the summer (mid-August)



Field Work Proposal

Department management is working with the lab to submit our FWPs for FY24-25

As discussed in the winter Muon Department retreat, we are prioritizing requests for project deliverables, and ops support required to complete the project

- Additional support is requested for computing, analysis, etc

Muon g-2 plans to operate the magnet for ~6 months in FY24, and then complete operations scope

Mu2e continues to ramp up operations



Office Space

- Want to ensure workspaces for everyone
 - Ideally personal cubicles for people here for extended periods
 - Improve isolation some have felt in the crossover (or offsite)
 - Ensure short-term visitors have places to work as well (some hoteling possible)
 - Some offices have been mostly unused in 3 years
- Discussing with (resident) Mu2e Early Career folks actions to improve the floor
 - Some other floors have storage lockers for regular visitors to store items in (as opposed to storage in desks in offices)
- During COVID-high, we adopted policy allowing people to use the glassed-in office on WH9E to have personal space with only a few people in the office
