



### **Updates And Trends**

- End of Covid restrictions for US-inbound travel, but consulates remain backlogged in many parts of the world
- H-1B lottery problems stay tuned for updates on next year's lottery
- Public comment period for significant increases in USCIS filing fees ended in March
- Premium processing continues to expand
- Visa bulletin may not advance until October
- DOL processing times remain extremely long
- EAD lawsuit settlement provisions provide opportunities for workers in dependent status, but terms for H-4 spouses are somewhat limiting



### Self-Sponsorship Permanent Residency Categories


### **EB-1 Extraordinary Ability:**

- One of the small percentage at the top of field
- Sustained national or international acclaim



#### **EB-2 National Interest Waiver:**

- Proposed endeavor has both substantial merit and national importance
- Well positioned to advance the proposed endeavor
- Beneficial to the US to waive the job offer and thus permanent labor certification requirements.




## EB-1 EA vs. EB-2 NIW

### **EB-1 EA**

- Avoids labor certification
- Allows self-sponsorship
- Very high standard
- National benefit not reqd.
- Specific criteria to meet
- Quasi-objective standard
- No quota backlogs

### EB-2 NIW

- Avoids labor certification
- Allows self-sponsorship
- Relatively high standard
- Benefit must be national
- More flexibility on evidence
- Subjective standard
- India & PRC quota backlogs



# **Extraordinary Ability Criteria**

• Must have <u>at least 3 of following</u>:

Awards for excellence Membership in organization requiring outstanding achievement Articles about employee Judging work of peers Original contributions of major significance Publications by employee Leading/critical role in organization with distinguished reputation High salary relative to peers Work displayed in artistic exhibitions\* Commercial success in performing arts\* \*Comparable evidence

- In lieu of 3/10 criteria, a major, internationally recognized award (e.g. Nobel Prize will satisfy the requirement
- Qualitative (comparative) analysis/evidence taken as a whole must indicate extraordinary ability





# Documentation for EB-1 EA and EB-2 NIW Cases



Expert letters (professional associations, employers, PhD advisers, government, etc.) Establish contributions to field Detailed and Specific In laymen's language

- Concrete examples
- Explain significance/benefit

#### **Other Documentation**

CV, list of publications, copies of degrees & transcripts Copies of publications & patents Citation list and copies of citing articles Copies of press or articles about employee work Copies of awards (criteria, significance, reputation) Membership documentation & membership criteria Peer reviewing of articles & judging awards/grants Impact factors of publishing & citing journals Conference participation (organizer or speaker)



## **Case Processing Steps**

#### **Case preparation**

- Document gathering
- Collecting expert letters
- Case drafting



#### I-140 Immigrant Visa Processing

- Variable based on USCIS processing times (https://eqov.uscis.gov/processing-times/)
- Premium processing is available for both case types
- Add more time if a Request for Evidence (RFE) received



#### I-485 Adjustment of Status (AOS) Processing

- Variable based on USCIS processing times Premium processing not available
- Option to concurrently file alternative forms of work and travel authorization (EAD and AP)
- File for Dependent Family Members at this Stage
- Potential to file this step concurrently with the I-140
