Site access:

The Fermi National Accelerator Laboratory (Fermilab) is an open site, and to gain access to the site you only need to show a government issued ID, such as a passport, driver's license, etc. Please tell the guard that you are attending a meeting in the HiRise, which is open to the public.

Site orientation:

The Project X muSR forum meeting will be 16:00 CDT Wednesday October 17th through 12:00 Friday October 19th CDT at Fermilab. The meeting will be held in Wilson hall, often referred to as the "Hi Rise", which is the tallest building on the site, and readily visible from anywhere on site.
