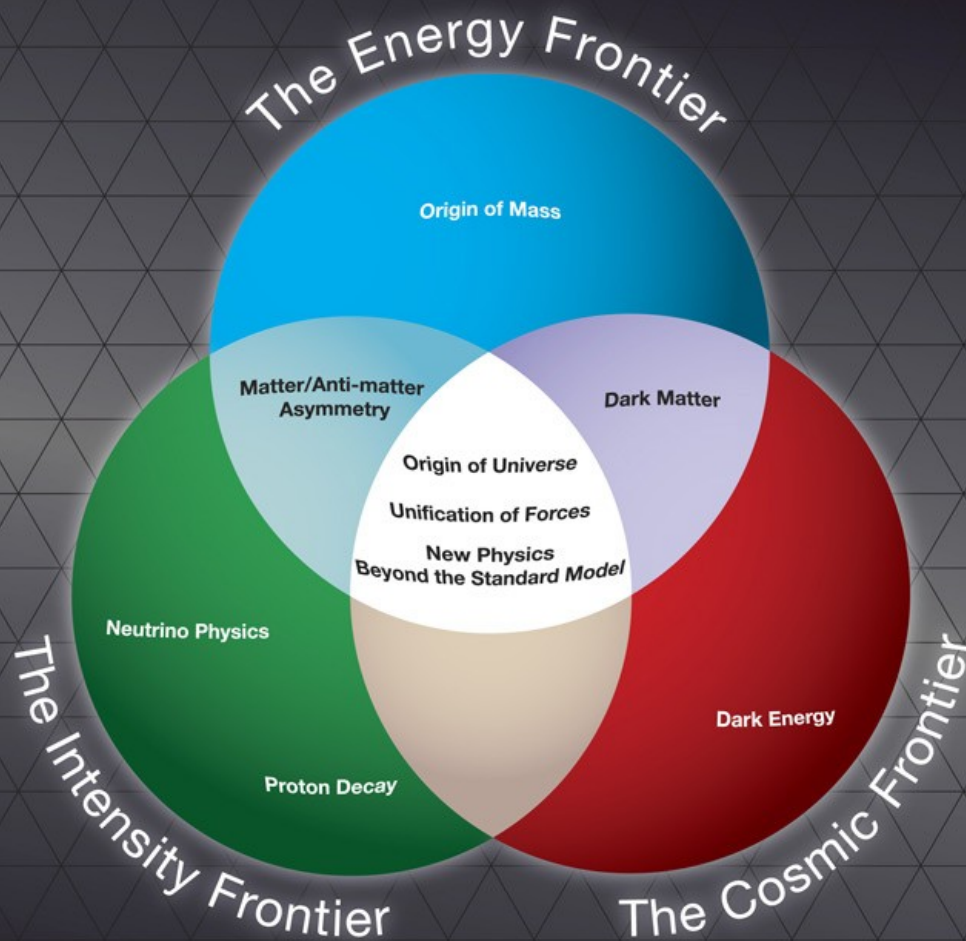

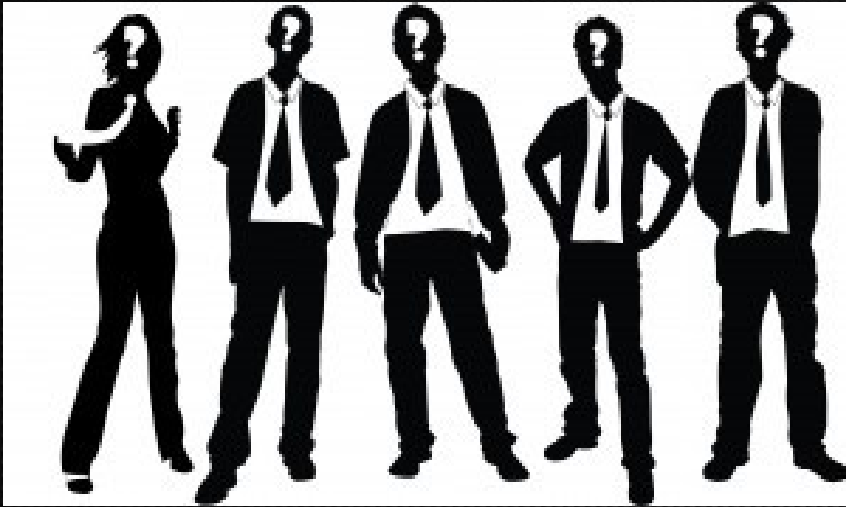

## The Snowmass Young Physicists Movement

*What is the most important physics in the coming years?*

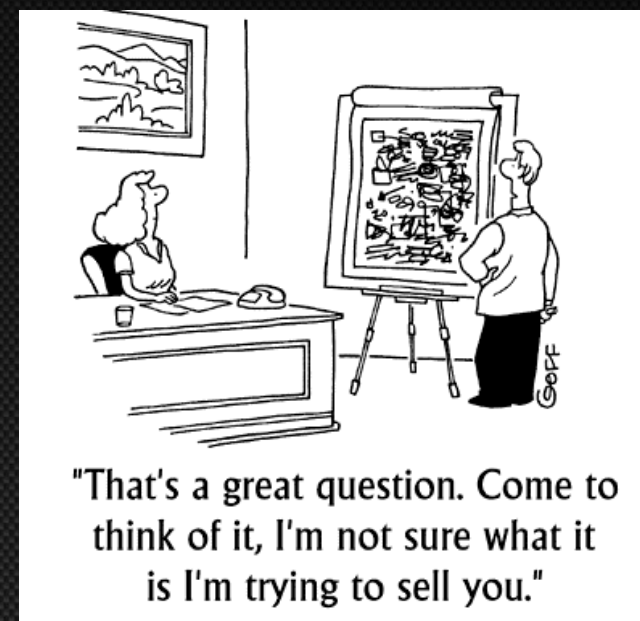
**Future experiment planners are not the future experimenters!**

## 4 Goals:

1) Generate a survey of the opinions young HEP physicists and compile the results as an input to the Snowmass process.



2) Participate in the Snowmass process by working / presenting / and taking part in the working group meetings leading up to the July Snowmass meeting in Minneapolis.

3) Become a long-term asset to the young physicists community by (including but not limited to) providing information and resources about experiments, career options, and outreach opportunities

4) Give young physicists a chance to network and get to know other people in their field
