## DC Trip Overview

  - o 2023: 40 participants
  - o 2024: aim for ~77 participants (to meet w/ every Congressional office)
    - 40 from FNAL/UEC
    - 10–15 from USLUA
    - 6–12 from SLUO
    - 2–3 from BNL, maybe a few from LBNL
  - o Budget scenarios: (also including \$2–3K for printing, shipping)
    - \$1400/person  $\rightarrow $57$ K total budget
    - $$1000/person \rightarrow $43K \text{ total budget}$
