APPROPRIATIONS UPDATE

Another Continuing Resolution

- In Just 3 days, funding expires for Energy programs
 - Another split or “laddered” CR has been agreed to
 - Bills that would be extended to March 1: Agriculture, Energy & Water, Military Construction, Transportation
 - Remaining Eight Bills would be extended to March 8
- Also in play: National Security and Border Supplemental funding
