

/app/ moves to /exp/app on February 21

/app/ disk will migrate to /exp/app on February 21, 2024

- The NFS file systems we use are end-of-life and must be retired by May at the latest.
- Fermilab will replace the NFS file systems with a new CephFS file system.
- **/app/ will be migrated to /exp/app on February 21.**
 - This will be done for you, but you will likely need to make some changes in scripts.
- Individual user home areas are on a different server and will not be affected.
- **You need to move your data on /data/ and /data2/ to /exp/data/ by March 20**
 - This move will not be done for you, you need to copy your materials over before that date.
 - Contact dune-data-mgmt@fnal.gov or Slack Channel **#computing-faq** if you have questions.
- This is a **quota-neutral move**—we get as much quota on the new system as we had on the old.

Current Status

- The new app and data areas are mounted on all of the dunegpvms as /exp/dune/app and /exp/dune/data but they are mostly blank at the moment.
- The /dune/app area will be **migrated for us** to /exp/dune/app on **Feb 21**.
- You will need to fix any script that point to /app/ but won't need to copy files

/dune/app considerations:

- Any cron jobs or scripts that have /dune/app or /dune/data in their paths will have to be changed.
- Any python virtual environments under /dune/app will have to be changed to adjust to the new path.
- Snapshots will still exist for the new app area, details on how to read them in the DUNE wiki

Pre-checking

- You can log into a special machine `dunecephptest01.fnal.gov` that has `/app/` mounted as `/exp/app/` so you can see where potential problems lie.
- Use this to test for hard-coded references to `/app/`

/dune/data needs to move by March 20

- /dune/data and /dune/data2 will become /exp/dune/data (no /data2/)
- DUNE is responsible for doing these transfers (not automatic)
- We propose not to move ancient stuff (pre-2015). It will be backed up to tape
- We propose not to move files from people who are long-gone. They will be backed up to tape.
