While at Argonne, you may see . . .

Our resident Sandhill Cranes. Two of these large birds have made Argonne their summer home for more than 5 years, raising a youngster in many of their stays here. These birds stand over 4 feet tall, have greyish brown plumage with a red crested head and formidable sharp beaks. They don't seem to mind hanging around the many varieties of scientist we have here at Argonne. They are mostly seen feeding on grubs and worms in the many grassy areas around the lab.

Also, there are deer in abundance – the brown Whitetail Deer common throughout the United States. You may even see a coyote loping across the lab. These forest and prairie dwellers have adapted extremely well to suburban living here.
