breakdown

- We have to carefully manage financial plan, schedule,...
 - IDEEO professionals usually have no budget to attend NuFACT
 - Full-attendance to the NuFACT is usually hard for IDEEO professionals
 - We have to fix our budget as early as possible to offer financial supports and book the schedule of the invited speakers
- LOC supports are crucial:
 - Local financial supports achieve IDEEO session in 2023&2024
 - Supports from LOC activate the career workshop in 2022
 - Invited speakers from nearby institutes of the venue are practically and conceptually nice and cost effective


List ups

- Travel and Accommodation Support (suggestion after NuFACT2023)
 support for IDEEO candidates who request it be made available from the meeting budget
- Local Organizer Involvement (suggestion after NuFACT2023)
 cost effective, cultural activities supportive to diversity and inclusion, good access to local facilities (logistics) importance of involvement of LOC for management of the session
- Hybrid/Remote Participation (suggestion after NuFACT2023)
 Hybrid conference participation, or at minimum the opportunity to present remotely, is preferred for fostering an inclusive and environmentally sustainable conference
- Visa Requirements and childcare support (suggestion after NuFACT2023)
 The process of securing a visa can be long, expensive, and emotionally taxing. Conference participants need at least 2-3 months to secure a visa. This means that they need to be accepted speakers at least 3 months in advance of the conference date. The more time that can be offered here, the better. Post-covid many embassies have a multi-month wait time for visa appointments.
- Plenary only + poster (no parallel) seem to fit current status of the community, if we compose a session.
