- To whom?
 - Early Career
 - Postdoc?
 - Junior facility?
- What type?
 - Is there any value to working with industry to get small financial awards?
 - Or is recognition sufficient?
- Process
 - Annual call for nominations?
 - The CPSC chooses some number of winners (2 per year)?
- Assessment
 - 5 year follow-up to examine if the awards are making the desired impact
