- 8-person team
- New LBLnet Manager in May
- 3 Vacancies remaining
 - interviews start next week
- Org chart change – Network and Security now report directly to CIO



Wireless Network

- **Wireless expansion, vendor change**
 - **Current wireless network ~ 200 Cisco autonomous AP's (mainly a/b/g)**
 - **In August will start rolling out ~600 Aruba controller-based a/b/g/n AP's**
- **Currently offer WPA2 employee SSID using standard lab credentials OR unencrypted, unauthenticated visitor SSID**
 - **90% of use is on "visitor" SSID**

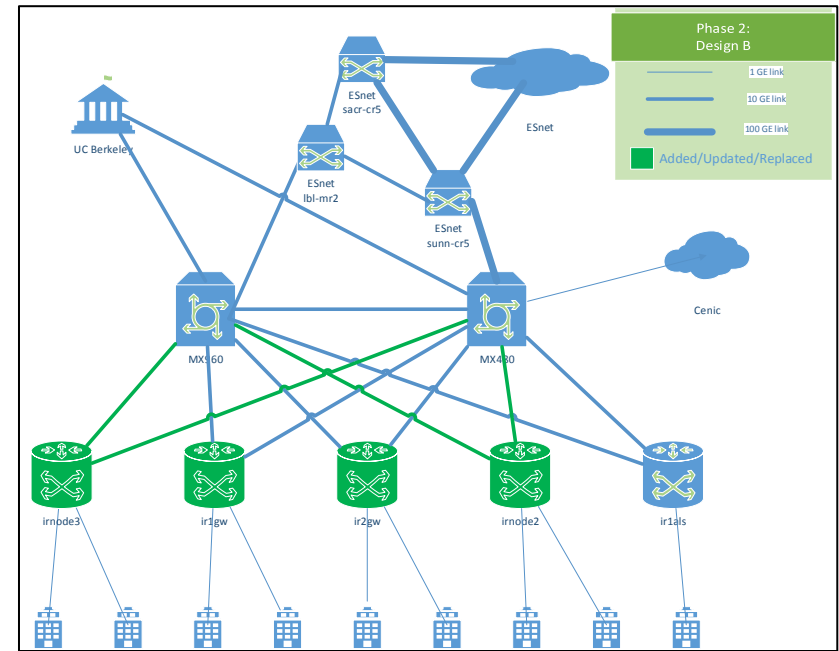
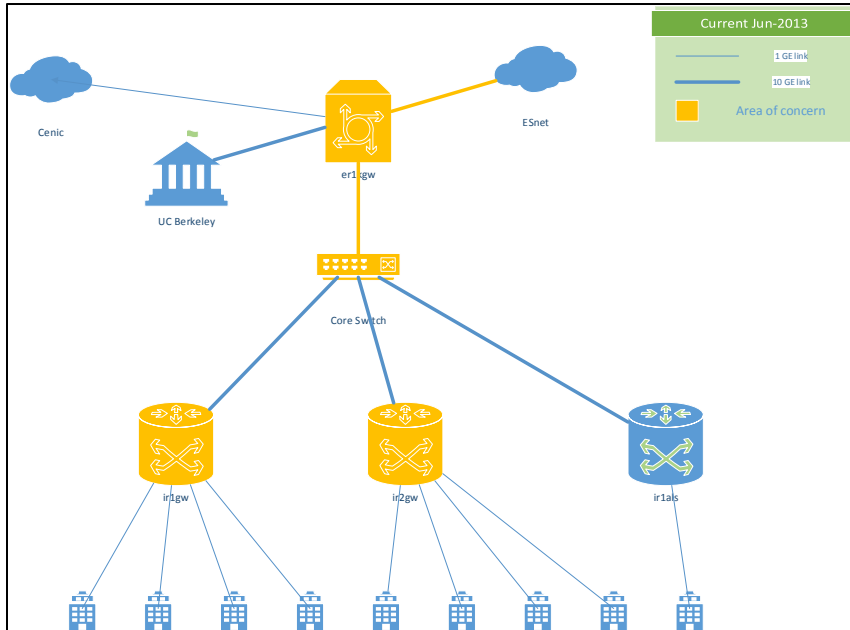


Router Replacements/100G Upgrade

- **Border Router Replacement**
 - **Old single Force10 replaced with pair of Juniper MX**
 - **Primary ESnet link upgraded from 10G to 100G**
 - **Should go live in September**
- **Site Core/Edge Router Upgrades**
 - **Currently core switch and two Cisco Cat6500 routers in same building**
 - **Planning to retire core switch and have four routers distributed around the site**
 - **Planning to add Science DMZ router**



Router Replacements/100G Upgrade



Multi-Vendor Edge

- Currently access/edge switches have all been from a single vendor
- Will get bids from several resellers in August for next year's switches with at least two competing switch vendors
